Biography

Dr. Ming Yang is senior environment economist in the Global Environment Facility of the World Bank Group based in Washington D.C., the U.S.A. His specialty covers energy efficiency, renewable energy, and transport programs in the GEF. Prior to joining the GEF/World Bank Group, Ming worked for four years as Energy and Environment Economist and Energy Technology Economist at the International Energy Agency of the Organization for Economic Co-operation and Development in Paris, for two years in the Asian Development Bank as energy adviser and climate change specialist, and five years in the Ministry of Electric Power of China as electric engineer and power system expansion planner. He was prime author for four books: (1) Energy Efficiency: Benefits Environment and Society (2015), (2) Closing the Gap (2013), (3) Negotiation in Decentralization (2012), and (4) Climate Policy Uncertainty and Investment Risk (2007); and co-author for two books: (1) Light's Labor's Lost (2006), and (2) Policy Support for the PRC 2020 (2003). In addition, he has written and published 45 peer-reviewed journal papers and 65 short newspaper articles in fields of energy, clean coal technologies, and climate change. Dr. Yang holds Ph.D. in energy economics, M.S. in power economics, and B.S. in electric power engineering.

杨明博士是一名环境经济学家，自 2010 年起就任于世界银行旗下的全球环境基金，在全球环境基金的主要研究方向为能源效率、可再生能源和运输项目。在加入全球环境基金之前，杨明博士曾作为能源环境技术专家在国际能源机构总部巴黎工作过四年；以能源和气候变化专家的身份在亚洲发展银行工作过两年；并任中国电力部电气工程师和电力系统扩展规划员，为期五年。
